- All procedure and investigation fees include reporting fees.
- These are standard charges but some may vary according to agreements with medical insurance companies.
- Patients paying for their own treatment, resident overseas or with non UK based insurers will be expected to settle charges in full on the day.
- Patients insured with UK based insurers will be required to provide a membership and pre-authorisation number for the invoices to be submitted directly to their insurer.
- Patients with medical insurance will remain liable for all charges until settled and will be asked to pay for invoices not settled within 3 months in addition to any policy excesses or items not covered by their insurer.
- A clinical referral is required for all xrays and ultrasounds apart from a mammogram. If you do not have a GP or other Doctor who can refer then our radiologists can undertake a consultation to determine the appropriateness of the investigation and sign the request form. The charge for this service is £150.
- Patients can self refer for a mammogram provided they are 40 or over and not had a mammogram in the last 12 months.
- In-patient surgical procedures are billed in accordance with insurance company guidelines and patients will be provided with the CCSD code to gain pre-authorisation for the procedure and admission from their insurers. Self pay patients will be provided with a fee estimate in advance of the procedure to cover surgeon, anaesthetist and hospital charges.
